### **GROUP TOURS**

Here at the Penn Center, we are able to design indoor and outdoor workshops for groups. The **York W. Bailey Museum** is open from 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday. Admission: \$5-adults; \$4-seniors; \$2-children. We also offer classes, demonstrations, lectures, and hands-on activities which may be arranged at various prices.

**Museum Scavenger Hunt** Discover the York W. Bailey Museum at Penn Center and its wonderful artifacts. Following a brief lecture of Penn School history, students discover, identify and collect items on a scavenger hunt. (Cost: \$175 per groups of 20)

**The Patchwork Quilt for Children** Learn the history of the patchwork quilt and participate in creating the history of your own quilt in a hands-on activity. (Cost: \$300)

**Indigo Demonstration** Meet a Nigerian batik and indigo artist-in-residence and learn about the history of indigo from Africa. Participate in hands-on indigo dyeing and create an original art piece (Call for prices)

**Family Across the Sea** Learn about the historical connection of the Gullah people of the Sea Islands to the people of Sierra Leone, West Africa. Lecture and video are included. (Cost: \$500)

**Sea Island Sweet Grass Basket Demonstration** The art of basket weaving is a generational tradition among descendants of African slaves. Find out how and where sweet grass grows and how baskets are designed. Meet an actual basket maker and learn the history of the art form. Starter kits for individual participants will be an additional cost. (Cost: \$500)

**Gullah Women in Storytelling** Listen and learn from Gullah stories that have their roots in the slave culture. A professional storyteller will delight audiences young and old. (Cost: \$300)

**Gullah Spirituals** Listen to the swaying and melodic voices of Gullah singers who continue the tradition of preserving the songs of freedom. Audience participation is welcome. (Cost: \$300)

**Guided Walking Tour** Enjoy a guided tour of Penn Center campus and learn the history of the buildings that are included in this Historic District. (Cost: \$100)

**Island Tour** Discover the rich culture of the Gullah community of St. Helena Island on a one-hour tour. (Call for prices)
